4. Enter your search as below using keywords (e.g. stress), the name of the institution as a phrase (e.g. Clark Atlanta University), and optionally the name of the school as a phrase (e.g. Social Work).

1. Go to the Library home page: <http://www.auctr.edu>
2. Under the section entitled, "**E-RESOURCES**," click on the following link:  
**Databases including GALILEO**
3. **Quick Select "D"** or scroll down to the "D" section of the alphabetical list.
3. Click on **Dissertation Abstracts**.

In most cases, the Woodruff Library will not own the dissertations that you find in this database. Initiate an **Interlibrary Loan (ILLiad)** request to order these publications. Interlibrary loan requests are typically filled in one week.
