LIBRARY SERVICE CHANGES: APRIL 2009 - APRIL 2010

Phase I of the Robert W. Woodruff Library renovation begins in May! When complete, Phase I of the renovation will result in a totally redesigned and refurbished Main Level Learning Commons, with Media Presentation & Creation Center, more collaborative study rooms, a new café, multipurpose classrooms and an after-hours study area. Phase I also will include significant enhancements to the Archives & Special Collections area on the Library's Upper Level and a new Graduate Study Suite, redesigned Reading Room, and reconfigured study, computation and lounging areas on the Lower Level.

The Library will continue to provide circulation, information and research consultation services throughout the construction. However, there will be changes in where, when and how those services will be provided. Here is a quick snapshot of expected service changes during the renovation project:
