3. Electronic Databases

ERIC (Education) (at EBSCOhost)

Provides journal articles and documents in all areas of education. Includes web access to the full-text of most ERIC documents (ED's) from 1993 to present.

Academic Search Complete

A comprehensive scholarly, multi-disciplinary full-text database, with more than 5,400 full-text periodicals, including more than 4,500 peer-reviewed journals etc.

Wilson Omnifile: Full Text Selected Edition

A multidisciplinary database providing full text articles, with their accompanying indexing and abstracts

KCDL (Kraus Curriculum Development Library)

A database that offers educational objectives, content, instructional strategies, and evaluative techniques for all subjects covered in PreK-12 and Adult Basic Education

JSTOR

Back issues of selected scholarly journals in ecology, economics, history, mathematics, music, political science, statistics, and other humanities and social sciences.

ProQuest Databases

Full text database that provides more than 1500 magazines and newspapers covering a very wide range of topics for researchers.

Mental Measurements Yearbook (MMY)

Fulltext information about standardized tests as included in the printed Mental Measurements Yearbooks. The database contains data from Yearbooks 9 through 16.

PsycARTICLES (at EBSCOhost)

Full-text of 57 journals, mostly published by the American Psychological Association (APA).

PsycINFO (at EBSCOhost)

Provides journal articles, books and dissertations in all areas of psychology.

Primary Search

Provides full-text for 60 popular magazines for elementary research.
