AUC Woodruff Library Extends Hours for Spring Mid-term Exam Period

Though renovation construction continues, the Atlanta University Center Woodruff Library will extend its hours of operation during the spring 2010 mid-term exam period. Beginning Monday, February 22, exam period library access will be as follows:

Open 7:30 AM – Close 2 AM

Saturday, February 27- Sunday, February 28

Open Noon – Close 2 AM

Monday, March 1-Thursday, March 4

Open 7:30 AM – Close 2 AM

During extended hours, users may expect the following:

- ▶ Library entry during mid-term exam period limited to visitors with valid AUC or ARCHE photo identification; Archives Research Center visitors with pre-arranged appointments will be allowed entry with valid, government-issued photo identification (e.g. driver's license, military ID, passport).
- ▶ Information Services Center will be staffed until 2 AM.
- ▶ Regular shuttle service will be available until MIDNIGHT. From 12-2 AM, a one-way shuttle will be available to transport students from the Library to their AUC campuses.
