AUC Woodruff Library Debuts New Building Access System

With the completion of the Atlanta University Center (AUC) Robert W. Woodruff Library's Phase I Renovation, a variety of

The new system eliminates the need for campus users with **VALID AUC ID** to stop at the security desk when entering the

This semester, the AUC Woodruff Library is implementing a new "card swipe" access system for the convenience of our AUC students, faculty and staff.

building.

Building access is immediately granted with a quick swipe of your valid AUC ID card in the new electronic card reader at the entrance turnstile.

During mid-term and final exam periods, when the Library offers 24-hour access, students, faculty and staff will also be able to swipe their ID through a card reader on the Library's exterior door for late night building entry.

Three years in the making, the card reader technology reads

Spaces available for booking include:

- ◆ 14 Group Study Rooms
- ◆ 2 Presentation Practice Studios
- ◆ 2 Audio/Visual Editing Studios
- ◆ 4 SMART Classrooms
- ◆ 2 Teaching Labs

Group study spaces are available for reservation by any member of the AUC community with a valid ID. AUC faculty members, with assistance from their subject area librarians, also may book "SMART" classrooms and teaching labs for curriculum-centered instruction.

orders at anytime from any place. This web-based job submission system provides AUC students, faculty and staff with 24-hour access to print services. Just click on the "AUC Library Document Center" icon on the Library home page (www.auctr.edu) and **in a few easy steps, you can:**

1. Submit your order
2. See and approve an electronic proof of the document
3. Get an estimated completion date and time
4. Arrange for pick-up
